DQAC MINUTES OF MEETING

The Meeting was held under the chairmanship of Shri Rahul Singh, DC (Revenue) SWD in conference hall, DC Office, Kapashera on 10-12-2019 at 11 AM.

Agenda of the meeting was as follows: -

- 1. SISC Monitoring visit findings of RTRM Hospital.
- Empanelment for PAIUCD, PPIUCD and Female Sterilization-empanelment requests received from SDDMASC, RTRM Hospital and District Medical Officers.
- 3. Establishment of Male window in Hospitals of South West District.
- 4. Any other issue with the permission of the Chair.

As DC (SWD) had to attend some other urgent matter, he asked CDMO, SWD to conduct the meeting.

All participants were welcomed by Dr. Rakesh Gilani CDMO, SWD and meeting was started with the permission of the chair.

Recommendation of committee:-

RCH Nodal asked both the hospitals to confirm to the format for maintaining family planning registers.

In SISC monitoring of RTRM Hospital, it was found that in case of MPA Injection clients were not counselled for menstrual changes, when to resume sexual activity, whether the injection would prevent RTI/STI infections etc.

The committee directed that proper counselling for MPA Injection should be done to prevent non-compliance& drop outs.

Dr. Hemlata & Dr. Priyanka from RTRM Hospital stressed that proper counselling is required at facility level for MPA injection& other methods of Family Planning.

The committee directed that re-training of ANMs & nursing staff be done to strengthen the counselling for MPA Injection.

In the SISC monitoring it was observed that NSV clients were not explained why it was necessary to collect the certificate. On client exit interview, the client had been given a printed handout at the time of discharge but it was not explained properly. He was also not aware of the compensation amount in case of failure . The committee members again stressed on the importance of proper pre and post NSV councelling.

RCH Nodal Officer, Dr. Devalina pointed out mismatch of HMIS Portal data of RTRM Hospital with that of reports submitted. Nodal Officer, (family planning) RTRM Hospital was directed by the committee to correct the matter immediately.

RCH Nodal Officer suggested that a monthly list of failure of client payments (IUCD & sterilisation) from the Hospital may be sent to the district office and tracked by desk review, will be done by District Nodal Officer, RCH.

Question was asked by SISC committee members, why the patients were not discharged after tubal ligation on the same day and kept for 48 hours in the Hospital. Dr. Priyanka family planning incharge RTRM hospital explained that after tubal ligation clients are kept for 24 to 48 hours for observation of any possible complication.

RCH Nodal Officer asked why there is delayed/no payment to empanelled surgeons performing sterilisation and clients undergoing sterilisation procedure. The Hospitals Nodal Officer replied that many cases are done by senior residents (as training cases) and hence, not paid since they are yet to be empanelled and some clients fail to furnish their account details despite repeated reminders.

Empanelment request received for PAIUCD, PPIUCD, Minilap & Laparoscopic ligation were reviewed by DISC members and were recommended for empanelment. The RCH Nodal Officer was directed to prepare empanelment certificates and sent to SDDMASC and RTRMH.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks.
