### Minutes of District Quality Assurance Committee Meeting

Meeting of District Quality Assurance Committee (DQAC) was held on 26.06.2023 at 11.30 am in the office of the District Magistrate (South East District) under the chairmanship of DM SED. Following DAQC members attended the meeting.

The meeting started with the introduction of all the members and the following agenda points were discussed.

1. Family planning programme and the performance of 2022-23 of the district was discussed. Although the programme of the district was better than the Delhi data as per NFHS5 report but due to large number of unauthorized colonies and resettlement colonies in the district, the family planning service had huge scope for expansion. The same will be targeted by the health units specifically in World Population day & fortnight 2023.
2. Massive IEC will be done in the community regarding World Population Day and fortnights which will start from 27<sup>th</sup> June and the same will be continued throughout the year to make a sustained effort to reach out to maximum eligible couples and bringing them under the umbrella of family planning.
3. The DPO-RCH discussed all the activities planned in the district during World Population fortnights.
  - i. Banners, posters and handbills printing will be done for all health facilities.
  - ii. Family planning orientation workshop for Anganwadi workers will be done.
  - iii. Family planning workshop for all AAMC Doctors will be done.
  - iv. WPD observation will be done with best performing 50 ASHAs of the district.
  - v. Umbrellas with family planning message will be distributed to 50 best performing ASHAs.
  - vi. Focus group discussion at 29 ASHA units will be planned.
  - vii. Health talk at 35 health centers will be done.
  - viii. 80 Family planning green wheel will be printed.
  - ix. Poster competition in 5 health facilities for ASHA worker & AWWs planned.

- x. 60 Parivar vikas samvad will be done in community by ANMs and banner will be printed.
  - xi. Painting competition will be done in HIMSR for the students.
  - xii. Stamps/OPD slip with family planning message will be printed.
  - xiii. Poetry competition on small family happy family among school children in Hindi/ English through online mode will be organized.
  - xiv. Free health talk at all health facilities will be done throughout the World population day & fortnights.
4. DPO-RCH informed that there are no family planning failure cases in the year 2022-23 & in 2023-24 till date.
  5. Member NSV surgeon Dr. H.K Mittal appraised the committee that the no IEC campaign is visible in the vulnerable pockets and this is a need for intensified IEC activities. It was decided that large hoardings shall be put up at prominent places and the IEC material given for WPD shall be utilized.
  6. It was decided to organize the fixed day services – female sterilization at Palika Maternity Hospital as only mini-lap is possible due to non availability of laparoscope. Mobilization of clients will be done through ASHA workers and incentive to the beneficiary will be paid by the hospital as per state norms. The patient will be kept under observation in hospital for 3 days.
  7. The applications of empanelment for female sterilization were put up before the committee and the following members were approved for the same.

  8. Chairperson inquired about the home delivery cases of South East District. It was informed by the member secretary that intensified and targeted intervention has been done by the district. Auditing of each case and line listing of Dais has been done and home deliveries are decreasing. The efforts will be sustained to further reduce home deliveries.
