Sub: Providing immediate medical treatment to patients suffering from heat stroke

Due to persistent high temperature prevailing in the city since the last one week, cases of persons suffering from heat stroke, due to prolonged exposure to high temperature, is expected to increase.

Heat stroke patients present with symptoms of fatigue, weakness, nausea, profuse sweating, muscle cramps, rapid shallow breathing, rapid pulse and tachycardia and paleness of skin. It can cause damage to brain and other organs.

Hospital authorities are directed to make necessary arrangements in their emergency department in the form of infrastructure (cooled area), manpower, medicines & IV fluids, ice packs etc.

All hospitals including private and nursing homes, functioning in the National Capital Territory of Delhi, are hereb76y further directed to attend to patients suffering from heat stroke, and provide them immediate medical treatment.
