Minutes of the Meeting

District Indemnity Sub-Committee (DISC) Meeting was held on 19.06.2023 at 11 AM through physical mode under the Chairmanship of District Magistrate (South) at Office of DM (South) MB Road, Saket, New Delhi-110017.

Meeting was attended by the following members:-

At the outset DM (South), Chairperson of the committee welcomed all.

Dr. Mamta Gupta, PO-RCH briefed about the agenda to be discussed followed by the brief introduction of members and the salient features of the Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS).

As per agenda of the meeting following two sterilization failure cases were discussed-

Case 1- Dimpal Devi W/o Pratap reported from Safdarjung Hospital-

- She was admitted on 15.06.2022 and underwent MTP with Minilap Ligation by empanelled surgeon Dr. Chhavi Gupta on 16.06.2022.
- Sample collected for histopathology report and final report showing Received two fallopian tubal segments in the same container both of which are microscopically unremarkable. Both show the presence of lumen.
- She was discharged on same day and advised to follow up
 - > To come for stich removal after 10days.
 - In case of missed periods attend FP OPD.
 - Collect Sterilization Certificate after 1st menstrual period or after 1 month.
- She came to Family Planning OPD on 29.08.2022 to collect the sterilization certificate after the menstrual period dated 27.08.2022.

- She was again visited the hospital on 08.02.2023 UPT Positive from outside. Repeat UPT showing Negative. Advised for USG, PA/PV was done. Pregnancy was confirmed.
- Repeat Procedure: MTP (D & E) + Tab Mala N on 14.02.2023
- Sample collected for histopathology report and showing Received multiple grey brown soft tissue piece altogether measuring 1.5 X 1X0.5 cm. Sectioned examined show features of product of gestation
- The case was discussed by members of quality circle at Safdarjung Hospital on 10.02.2023 and following observations were made:
 - o The most probable cause of failure was spontaneous recanalization.

Case 2- Chetna Jaywant W/o Karamveer reported from AIIMS-

- She had undergone interval laparoscopic bilateral tubal ligation on 11.12.2021 at AIIMS by empanelled surgeon Dr. Saumya Kulshrestha.
- She received her ligation certificate after resuming her menstrual cycles on 28.01.2022.
- She again visited OPD on 30.01.2023 with complaints of pain abdomen since in the last four days, with her LMP being 15.12.2022.UPT was done positive and USG was done which confirmed left tubal ectopic pregnancy.
- She underwent Laparoscopic Bilateral Salpingectomy under general anaesthesia on 30.01.2023.
- Sample collected for histopathology report and showing –
- o Left tube and products of conception comprises of a tubal structures measuring 4.3 cm in length and attached soft tissue with blood clot measuring 3.2X3X1cm. No fetal parts are identified grossly.
- Multiple sections examined shows chorionic villi, decasualized stoma attached to serosal aspect of tube with un remarkable fallopian tube lining. Features are consistent with tubal ectopic pregnancy.
- The case was discussed by members of quality circle at AIIMS on 20.03.2023 and following observations were made:-
- o The procedure was technically successful and probable cause of failure can be attributed to the background risk of failure of female sterilization.

Dr. Mamta Pandey reviewed the both case file in detail and asked about the status of requisite documentation.

Dr. Mamta Gupta informed that all necessary documents (Claim Form, Consent Form, Sterilization Certificate, Proof of Failure) are available with the claim file for both cases.

Committee members concluded cause of failure as follows-

Case 1- Failure of ligation due to Spontaneous recanalization.

Case 2- Failure attributed to known background risk of failure of ligation.

The committee members unanimously decided and recommended that the sterilization failure cases of Dimpal Devi W/o Pratap and Chetna Jaywant W/o Karamveer are eligible to release compensation money as per Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS). The claim file may be forwarded to SPO-Family Planning for reviewing the case & final settlement.

District Magistrate (South) suggested following points-

- 1. Generate more awareness about Indemnity scheme. At the same time Dr. Yamini Sarwal, informed that all patients undergoing sterilization are counseled about the small risk of ligation failure and compensation guidelines under FPIS verbally as well as in writing.
- 2. Take quarterly report from all accredited hospitals.
