Minutes of Meeting

A meeting of State Indemnity Subcommittee (16th SISC Meeting) was held on 14.08.2020 at 11:00 AM at 6th floor, DSHM through online mode under the chairmanship of Mission Director, DSHM.

The meeting was attended by following officers:

- 1. Dr. Monika Rana, Director, Directorate of Family Welfare
- 2. Dr. Jyoti Sachdeva, State Program Officer (Family Planning), DFW (Convener)
- 3. Dr. Puneeta Mahajan, Empanelled gynaecologist, (Member)
- 4. Dr. Chandan Bortamuly, Empanelled NSV surgeon, (Member)

Following agenda were discussed:

Agenda 1: Action taken on Proceedings of 15" SISC meeting.

The committee was informed that:

- Sanction orders for earlier cleared claims have been issued (Both sources).
- Minutes along with Reiteratory advisories on important recommendations have been issued
- Video Laparoscopes and Camera suggested in last meeting have been got approved in ROP 2020-21.
 Process of dissemination of funds has been started .

Agenda 2: Scrutinyof the 19 (Nineteen) cases of Sterilization Failure reported under Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS) after 15th SISC meeting.

- The case summaries and submitted documents of all reported cases of failures of sterilization, a total
 of 19 (Nineteen) cases were presented before the committee and discussed one by one (18 cases
 from 2019-20 and 1 case from 2020-21).
- The cases belonged to 7 districts (South East, South West, South, West, North-West, Central and Shahdara). The respective District Indemnity Sub Committees/ District Quality Assurance Committees had submitted the cases after recommendation at district level.
- 17 (Seventeen) out of the total cases were recommended for compensation (16 cases from 2019-2020 and 1 case from 2020-21) (See Tables 1 and 2). 5 (Five) of the seventeen recommended cases have been conditionally recommended subject to reasons mentioned against these cases (See Table 3). For these cases, sanction order to be issued after fulfilling the respective conditions.
- 1 (One) case was deferred for further needful as mentioned in Table 4.
- 1 (One) case was referred back to concerned hospital with direction mentioned in Table 4.



During case discussions, some advisories/guidelines were given by the Director and members which

A. For DQAC members:

- The Committee recommended that cause of failure to be thoughtfully and rationally assigned. Assigning any of the following is not acceptable for obvious reasons. > Failure of sterilization

 - > Slippage or breakage of Falope ring assigned as reason when repeat procedure has not
- If ultrasound report is not available along with Urine Pregnancy Test (UPT) documentation, additional proof in the form of undisputed/non-borderline examination findings (i.e. other than bulky uterus) or histopathology of products of conception may be made available.
- DQAC members may carefully look into the case review by quality circle; all details and quality of documents; discrepancy in names of claimant/spouse, if any among different documents submitted and discuss/resolve the same before submission to DFW. The name in which sanction order is to be issued must be clearly intimated to this Directorate to facilitate hassle



In this context, the committee members recommended that Districts with poor documentation of DQAC be communicated need for improvement in quality of meeting and its documentation.

Action: State Program Officer (Family Planning)

B. For Service Providers:

- Relteratory advisory for service providers for switching to minilap in cases where tubes are found to be thick on laproscopy. Alternatively, hysterosalpingography (HSG) to be considered before certification.
- In view of repeated deficiencies in files submitted by RTRM hospital, quality of documentation to be ensured again through a repeat letter to Medical superintendent & Head of Department and DISC/SISC visit in near future to countercheck implementation.
- Several blank columns in consent forms of Lok Nayak Hospital and few other hospitals was pointed out for prospective correction.

Agenda 3: Deliberation and decision on earlier deferred case of Vikrant S/o Dharampal (North West District)

After deliberations the case was conditionally recommended for compensation subject to satisfaction of Dr. Chandan Bortamuly based on following reports:

- Authentication of previous reports by Pathologist, Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Hospital (SGMH).
 Since case record of last three years is stated by SGMH to be available, at least the report belonging to 2018 must be authenticated and submitted.
- Repeat semen analysis at Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Hospital because Lok Nayak Hospital is currently a designated COVID hospital. Claimant needs to submit the report within 2 weeks of receipt of notification in this regard from the concerned district.

Agenda 4: Actions related to actual/likely impact of COVID-19 on Family Planning Program

Dr. Jyoti Sachdeva highlighted the anticipated and situational impact of the pandemic on family planning services and efforts undertaken to revive the same. Further, she sought opinion of committee members on strategies to restart sterilization services (particularly NSV) which have suffered the worst impact.

Following opinions were given:

- Dr. Puneeta advised to follow the state specific guidelines and/or local SOPs based on the same as the situation of all states and individual hospitals are peculiar.
- Dr. Chandan Bortamuly said that keeping in mind the unknown status of disease and risk involved due to hospital visit/procedure, restarting NSV services may wait till other elective surgery services start as per evolving situation.
- In larger interest of the state, family planning procedures may be resumed as per hospital specific SOPs of non COVID hospitals.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the Director.
