PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

- The Mobile Dental Clinics (MDC) and Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Mobile Dental Vans work in collaboration with Six Delhi Government Dispensaries.
- The Six have been divided into Two clusters were formed each consisting of One MDC and Two IEC Vans covering 3 dispensaries on rotational and regular basis:
 - 1. Cluster 1: Shiv Vihar, Chauhan Pati and Gokulpuri
 - 2. Cluster 2: Arvind Nagar, Khajurikhas and Gautam Puri.
- From this month, Mobile Dental Vans Project has collaborated with School Health Scheme, GNCT of Delhi. At present, 4 Delhi Government Schools have been adopted to render our oral services.

DAILY SCHEDULE

- Vehicles are stationed from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM for five days a week in each of the
 identified dispensaries on rotational basis except for the four Information, Education
 and Communication Mobile Vans, which are now catering their services for four
 days in a week at dispensary site.
- Every Wednesday of the month has been designated for creating awareness and rendering oral care to the schools under School Health Scheme, GNCT of Delhi by Information, Education and Communication Mobile Vans (IEC Vans).
- Currently, four schools under school health scheme have already been selected and the screening and health educational services are being provided.












7) Health Education Services in the Community:






11) <u>COMPARATIVE EVALUTION OF SERVICES RENDERED FROM</u> MAY –SEPTEMBER 2014
