BRIEF REPORT

INTRODUCTION

Like last several years, **World Population Day** Campaign was observed in Delhi this year too. The theme percolated was



Working towards percolation of the slogan to each and every member of the system from absolute top to the ultimate down the line Health care Worker and ultimately to the eligible couple, and to make everyone understand the concept of the slogan, intensive efforts were made in cascade manner. At the peak of the campaign the slogan was on all lips and visible and audible everywhere. The concept was very well understood and it showed in the artworks of all including nursing students, school students, ASHAs and other participants at Melas and Rallies.

TIME PERIOD OF THE CAMPAIGN

Observation of following day and fortnights was done:

- World Population Day (WPD): 11th July.
- Dampati Sampark Pakhwada (DSP) or, Mobilization Fortnight (27th June to 10th July).
- Jansankhya Sthirta Pakhwada (JSP) or, Population Stabilization Fortnight (PSF) or Family Health Mela (11th July to 24th July)

GOALS OF THE CAMPAIGN

The campaign was celebrated with following general and specific goals in mind:

- Mass awareness
- Wide spread convergence
- Boost ongoing thrust areas (Male participation, PPFP & PAFP and newer contraceptives)
- Intensified service delivery

Stricter adherence to standards and Quality of Services

In general, the fortnights serve the purpose of bringing an annual thrust to the FP program and also remind us of our responsibility towards the very vital FP services including mobilization through good.

ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY STATE OF DELHI FOR OBSERVATION OF THE WPD CAMPAIGN 2019 WERE AS FOLLOWS:

I. LAYING THE FOUNDATION:

- A series of district wise FP review meetings dated 16th & 21st May and 4th June 2019 which were attended by service providers from all facilities and stakeholders from all districts and departments were used as a preparatory platform for advance sensitization for a super intensive WPD campaign in Delhi for 2019. All were shown the outcomes of prior year campaigns and gaps were also discussed. Storming of the intellect brains was done and new strategies for upcoming WPD were formulated. Additionalities for campaign 2019 were floated from both ends (Chair and audience)
- Another state level meeting with organisers of various Family Planning camps (FDS) planned during 2nd fortnight was conducted on 2nd July, 2019 whereby the agenda were dedicated to mobilization strategies and foolproof preparedness for delivery of quality services in a client friendly manner. Also service delivery compliant with all standards was ensured by video demonstration, hands on demonstration and frequently encountered gaps on inspection visits Minutes annexed (See Annexure I)



• A cascade of such sensitization, motivating meetings at district, facility and ASHA unit levels followed. (See Annexure II for details).

Sensitization meetings in hospitals were attended by concerned specialists/general medics/paramedical and even non-medical personnel. (Support and Security Staff) and were chaired by Medical Superintendent, MS-MCH, HOD Gynae. or FP Nodal Officers (See Annexure III)

- Thrust on MPA in Post Partum period (6 weeks) and PAIUCD were decided as hyper focus areas as lot of scope was realised in these areas.
- Each District agreed to come up with one or the other **innovative/new strategy** for extending the campaigns beyond usual boundaries.

II. BUILDING UP THE TEMPO AND RESOURCE GATHERING:

- Refresher Trainings were conducted for ASHAs across districts on newer methods and schemes.
- Convergence was re established, strengthened, streamlined with AYUSH, Mobile Health Scheme, Education Department, Delhi State AIDS Control Society (DSACS), Academic bodies, Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board (DUSIB), Women & Child Development Department etc. as a preparation for multi department participation to give the campaign a broad based foundation.
- Printed **Banners**, In-house **art works**, myth busting **flyers** were bulk prepared for display/distribution at facilities, clinics, rallies, melas etc.
- OPD slips, Scroll messages, etc in hospitals read family planning messages and awareness slogans.

III. SETTING THE BALL ROLL THROUGH IEC/BCC ACTIVITIES:

The mobilization fortnight started with plethora of Behaviour change communication activities:

• Newspaper coverage in newspapers at state level was done on 11th July. Districts South West and North and also spread awareness through articles in newspaper.



• **Metro** panel display for wide publicity among young couples in several routes and coaches was done.



• Autorickshaws were also used as mass media for message percolation among daily passengers.



- Health website of Delhi not only featured the event information but also for first time, men seeking FP advise would know where to go (Hospital wise details) **See the Annexure IV**.
- Melas and other Mega events were conducted and attended by masses (see Table 1 for district wise details)

- Focus Group Discussions and Health talks: Overall approximately 8948 were conducted with around 1,00,000 participants.
- The **Pre Camp publicity** was done through ASHAs, Munadis, flyers, mobile vans and other announcement modalities.
- ASHAs helped to disseminate information on important issues through pamphlets in facilities and community(PPIUCD and PAIUCD and Male participation)

IV. CATERING TO UNMET NEED EVERYWHERE:

- Counselling desks for contraceptive selection support were set-up in each facility.
- All nooks and corners of the Hospitals were covered either by help desks or interactive sessions with relevant audience on Family Planning issues.

- Audience in various areas were gathered for health talks.





- Multiple FP Corners and desks set up.
- In house IEC prepared and displayed. (JPCH, A&U Tibia, DDU, SVBP, GTB and many other hospitals).



• Competitions (Poster/Slogan/Quiz) among Nurses, resident doctors and other staff conducted.

- Convergence with AYUSH, PPTCT, ICTC, ART, TB clinics and may other departments. Special appreciation GTB hospital, SVBP, SJH.
- Counselling rooms given new look.
- Male windows established, signaged and publised.
- Attractive baskets prepared for counselling. (BJRM, A&U Tibia etc.)
- **Screens** installed for running videos at waiting areas. (SVBP upgraded their counselling room and established a screen for running videos).
- Medical and Nursing students involved into the campaign. After all they are future service
 providers and timely sensitization will go a long way. They presented skits, participated in
 competitions and counselling too.
- BJRM conducted a plantation drive in the name of Family Planning.
- Invoking and discovering Talents among different staff was done through slogan competition in BJRM and poster/quiz competitions in LHMC, ABGH, SVBP etc.
- Faculty members of Gynae. Department all got involved deeply and supported FP Nodal officers in campaign.

VII. MATERNITY HOMES AND PRIMARY FACILITIES:

- Community need assessment started well before the campaign and this was taken as an opportunity to focus on yellow couples (unmet need).
- ASHAs embarked into the field with never before enthusiasm as this time they had been primed and prepared during the dedicated FP workshops conducted by districts.
- Several batches of ASHAs were addressed directly by service providers at hospitals (SVBP, SDDMASC, LNH, BJRM, BSA and many others). This gave them confidence not only in motivating, dispelling myths but also could facilitate procedures more efficiently.
- Several PUHCs including MCW centers and Maternity Homes observed Saas Bahu Samelaan.

- Rallies were organised by Seed PUHC Sriram colony, DGD Gautampuri, DGD
 Nandnagari, dispensaries of North East and Shahdara districts respectively.
- Multitude of IEC/IPC/Mid media modalities were used for mobilization.
- 18 PUHCs and 5 Maternity Homes conducted IUCD camps
- Out of the total state performance 1368 IUCD, 224 MPA and 13,207 Oral pills were performed at PUHCs and Maternity Homes.

VIII. <u>INTENSIVE PROMOTION OF MALE PARTICIPATION AND ENCOURAGING NSV:</u>

• Rooms for men seeking FP counselling were earmarked and signages.





XIII. QUALITY INITIATIVES DURING CAMPAIGN PERIODS:
